

**Q: What is the Accure Acne Treatment?**

**A:** Accure is a new treatment, utilizing a unique laser wavelength specifically for acne. The treatment safely and effectively denatures the sebaceous gland, reducing the production of sebum (oil). By normalizing the amount of oil produced, the appearance of facial or body acne is significantly improved.

**Q: How long will it take to see results?**
